What are the means available for research?

France has abilities, researchers - including young researchers - but unfortunately, she has no budgets. In addition, this issue is still considered to be a "customer service" not noble enough.

Dr. Sylvie DELANIAN Oncologist Radiotherapist, St. Louis hospital:

All these works are ongoing because they are supported by the goodwill of individuals who met and decided to address a problem to try to limit the suffering of patients. Compassion, it's our job, but... to go beyond.

Dr. Pierre-François PRADAT Neurologist, La Pitié-Salpêtrière hospital:

We have the ability, we have researchers, we meet young researchers who would like to work on this area permanently, unfortunately there are no budgets. It's sad, but they will work in other laboratories on subjects that are more fashionable, for which it is easier to find research grants.

Dr. Sylvie DELANIAN Oncologist Radiotherapist, St. Louis hospital:

You have to have a few more working with means.

Dr. Pierre-François PRADAT Neurologist, La Pitié-Salpêtrière hospital:

And then in our areas that are neurological diseases, there is the issue of disability. And patients who have difficulties, on the day for things that seem the simplest of everyday life. So it is a duty to help them, and I would say that it is a duty to help them regardless of their geographical origin and regardless of their social status so that they can all benefit from aid schemes, which incidentally, sometimes exist but which are not well known and for which networks are insufficiently developed.
